J.E.A. Crake / George C. Lemmon Bursary for Study in Theology

The J.E.A. Crake Foundation, established by the late Dr. J. Ernest A. Crake, Josiah Wood Professor of Classics at Mount Allison University, 1946–1976, supports the Anglican Church, particularly the Parish of Sackville, (St. Ann's and St. Paul's Churches), and also the Parish of Dorchester and the Parish of Westmorland. Dr. Crake was Treasurer of Sackville Parish and an active Lay Reader, from time to time conducting services in every church within these three parishes. The Reverend George Colborne Lemmon served in many parishes in New Brunswick, including Sackville (1972-1983). He became the seventh Bishop of Fredericton in 1989, serving in that postiion until 2000.

The Foundation offers bursary support for those studying theology for the ordained ministry in the Diocese of Fredericton.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. All those who are recommended for postulancy by the Advisory Committee on Postulants for Ordination, are eligible to apply.
- 2. All bursaries will be used for formal study leading to a degree or certificate which forms part of the theological training and formation for ordained ministry.
- 3. Primary consideration for support will be given to candidates from the Parishes of Sackville, Dorchester, and Westmorland.

Procedures

- 1. Applications for bursaries are made to the Bishop of Fredericton before May 30.
- 2. A Committee will make recommendations to the Bishop who will make the final decision by June 15. Funding amounts will be at the discretion of the Bishop.
- 3. A report must be made by each recipient to the Bishop's office as soon as the program of study is finished.
- 4. The Diocese will supply the Foundation by November 20 with a brief report regarding awards made, and the total of the grants made that year.
- 5. The deposit of funds to the Diocese will be made by January 2 each year.
- 6. A receipt will be supplied by the Diocese to the Foundation by January 30.

Award funding available: up to \$8000 year.
