## AUTHORIZED LITURGICAL TEXTS

1. The Book of Common Prayer (1962) is the official prayer book of the Anglican Church of Canada. Only the Book of Common Prayer and the Book of Alternative Services (1985) are authorized for use. Texts authorized elsewhere in the Anglican Communion may be used with the Bishop's permission.

It is strongly recommended that all parishes use the Book of Alternative Services at least occasionally.

- 2. The Revised Common Lectionary (RCL) and its corresponding calendar should be used at principal services on Sundays for either the Holy Eucharist or Services of the Word. Other lectionaries, including that of the Book of Common Prayer, may be appropriate on weekdays, festivals or special occasions during the Christian Year.
- 3. Hymn books authorized for use are those recognized as hymnals by the Anglican Church of Canada, including:

The Book of Common Praise (1938) The Hymn Book (1979) Common Praise (1998) Mission Praise (1984 and succeeding)

A Christian Copyright License International (CCLI) license or other copyright permission should be used for displaying song texts, photocopying music, and/or recording worship of/with music still under copyright.
