# Advent Family Devotions

We encourage all families in our parish to observe Advent at home, beginning next Sunday, December 3<sup>rd</sup>. In most Christian homes the Advent wreath is placed on a table. The wreath is a simple one of cedar, pine, fir or any other evergreen. Many families enjoy the satisfaction of making their own wreath. It can be made on a frame of wood or metal. At four equidistant points around the circumference of the circle, candleholders are placed and candles inserted - 4 purple (around the circumference) and 1 while (in the centre).

The first candle should be lighted during family devotions on the First Sunday in Advent. The same candle is relighted each evening (before supper) during the week. An additional candle is lighted during the second week, a third the third week, and a final purple candle the fourth week. On Christmas Eve the white Christ Candle is lighted also.

The candle lighting should take place in connection with a Bible reading, one of prophecy from the Old Testament.

The following family liturgy can be used to begin family devotions on the First Sunday in Advent when the entire family gathers for the blessing of the wreath:

Leader: Our help is in the name of the Lord, All: who made heaven and earth.

Leader: O God, by whose Word all things are sanctified, pour out your blessing upon this

wreath, and grant that we may prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ Jesus,

your Son and our Lord, in whose Name we pray.

All: Amen.

Scripture lessons and prayer for the first week follow. Then the first candle is lighted.

# First Week

Two candles are lighted and allowed to burn as before.

#### **Christmas Eve**

Scripture Lessons to be read - Zechariah 2:10-end, Hebrews 2:10-18

Leader: Almighty God, who hast given us thy only begotten Son to take our

nature upon him, and as at this time to be born of a pure Virgin: Grant that we being regenerate, and made thy children by adoption and grace, may daily be renewed by thy Holy Spirit; through the same our

Lord Jesus Christ, who liveth and reigneth with thee and the same

Spirit, ever one God, world without end.

All: Amen.

All candles are lighted including the Christ candle.

# **Christmas Day**

Scripture Lessons to be read - Isaiah 9:2-7, Matthew 1:18-25

Leader: O God, who makest us glad with the yearly remembrance of the birth

of thy only Son Jesus Christ: Grant that as we joyfully receive him as our Redeemer, we may with sure confidence behold him when he shall come again to be our Judge; who liveth and reigneth with thee

and the Holy Spirit, now and ever.

All: Amen.

All candles are lighted throughout the days of Christmas including the Epiphany of our Lord Jesus.
