We see this as an outreach of service and spreading of the gospel which aligns with our mission to **Know God and Make Him Known**.

Additionally, we would like to provide opportunities for these folks to do meaningful work that will assist other. Ideas include having them help pack meal kits to be distributed to those in need in our area.

We will combine the meal with a brief Bible reading and prayer.
