

COURSE TITLE: WORSHIP: THE LORD'S PRAYER

Designation: Core Requirement for All Layreaders

Overview

When we pray the Lord's Prayer, we are praying for what Jesus wants to happen in the world. We live in a time, as Jesus did, in a world all too full of injustice, hunger, and malice. This prayer cries out for justice, bread, forgiveness and deliverance.

Objectives

- 1. Describe how the Lord's Prayer impacts our understanding of *Meeting a Gracious God;* Fixing a Broken World; Satisfying the Hungry Heart; Healing a Wounded Family; and Facing Our Worst Fears.

- 3. Describe the difference between being a boarder or a family member.
